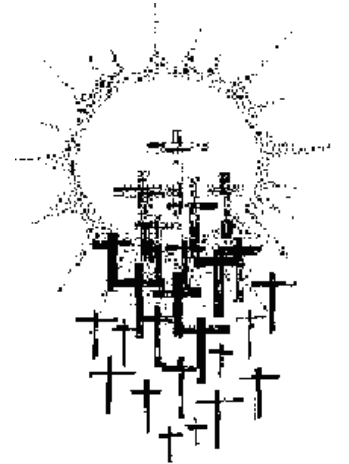

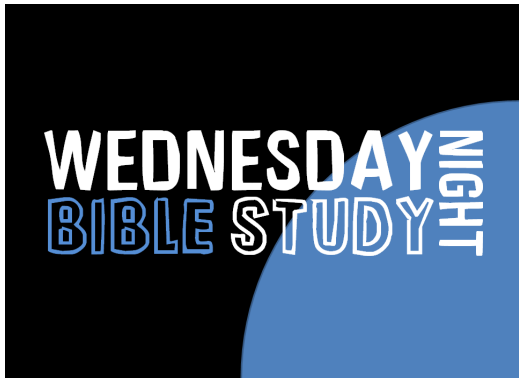

**Pastor's Bible Study:** A Bible study based on the upcoming sermon. Come and grow as you preview the Bible text of each sermon. This class is located in the office. Leader: Randy Coleman

The Wednesday Parlor Bible study, is going through *Disciple: Under the Tree of Life* (New Testament part), which covers the Gospel of John, the Epistles of John, James, Jude, and finally Revelation. Each week includes a selection from Psalms (the Bible's prayer book).
