



Mt. of Olives in the Old Testament

- King David mourned on the Mt. of Olives
- Solomon was anointed king in the area of the Mt. of Olives

II. In the garden, the true king is revealed




"Blessings on the king who comes in the name of the Lord. Peace in heaven and glory in the highest heaven," they shouted (v. 38).
