Q: What is the camp schedule?

A: 6:30-6:50 pm Assembly Gathering

When the weather is nice, we will have the assembly times and games outdoors!!

Q: What should my kids wear?

A: Please wear comfortable clothing you can get dirty or messy! We will have games outdoors in good weather, and we will participate in science experiments and crafts throughout the week.

Q: My child is not in the required age range, can they still participate?

A: While we wish to accommodate everyone, this age range was chosen to help our volunteer staff safely care for each child. Participants must also be fully potty trained, as we do not have services on site to change diapers or pull ups.

Q: Can I come stay with my child?

A: We cannot be responsible for a child outside of VBS age range as we have no childcare available. Please be mindful of this as you might be bringing a child outside of that range.

Q: Will there be photos or videos taken during camp?

A: Staff members on site will be capturing camp moments on camera. Please make sure to note on your registration form if you do not want your child photographed.

Q: What happens if my child gets hurt?

A: We have emergency protocols. Each group leader has a first aid kit with them at all times should a child fall and get a small cut. In the event of any injury, an incident form will be filled out and a copy given to the parent at pick up. If the injury affects the head or is severe, parents will be notified. In the case of severe injury, 911 will promptly be called and care given. Please designate on the registration form you give us permission to transport your child by ambulance to a nearby hospital if necessary.

Q: Can I serve as a camp leader?

A: Yes! All volunteer staff are background checked. We also follow the 2 person rule! Children are within sight of multiple staff members throughout every evening.
